

- E. If boys who go home for the weekend wish to take a guest or two with them, their parents should notify the school of permission. Parents of boys who may wish to visit in homes of other students, or in nearby homes of relatives, must have on file with the school permission to make such visits. This may be a blanket permission, leaving individual visiting occasions to the discretion of the school.
- F. There is a supervised one-hour study hall five nights a week which all boarding students must attend.
- G. There is close supervision of personal cleanliness, and rooms and beds are inspected for cleanliness and neatness daily.
- H. We have arranged with a Princeton barber to come to the school one night a week. He has agreed to a special price of \$1.00 per boy and this is charged to the boy's Student Bank Account.
- I. We have a traditional birthday celebration which takes place at lunch on the student's birthday. Parents should advise us several days in advance of their son's birthday whether they wish a decorated birthday cake for his table only (\$2.25) or a decorated cake for his table plus sheet cake sufficient for the entire dining room (\$5.00). We have arranged with a local bakery to provide excellent cakes at these special prices.
- J. Itineraries of Concert Tours are mailed to parents of boys from the office, just as soon as reservations are completed. A list of touring boys is included with the itinerary for each tour, although changes may be made in this list at the last minute for health or other reasons.
- K. PX is a small "store" run by the boys (with the supervision of a staff member). Here the boys may purchase such items as soap, tissues, toothpaste and toothbrushes, combs, flashlights and batteries, candy (we limit purchase of candy), such school supplies as notebooks, paper, pencils, rulers, stationery, stamps, etc. The PX is maintained for the convenience of the students, and any items that a majority of the boys request may be added to the stock.
- L. The dining room is filled to capacity with students and staff except on weekends and when the concert choir is on tour. At the latter times we are glad to have parents with us for a meal if given at least a 24-hour notice. A nominal charge will be made.

HEALTH

- A. The school has arranged for a doctor to attend our boys at any hour of the day or night. In emergency cases, the doctor visits the boy at our infirmary; otherwise the boy is taken to the doctor's office. Doctor bills are sent directly to the parents by the doctor.
